- My team and I developed a full-stack nutrition tracking application that uses AI to parse natural-language meal descriptions into structured, editable food log entries. Integrated USDA backed food data for accurate macro and micronutrient tracking across thirteen nutrients, alongside wellness features for water intake, sleep, and cardio activity (React, TypeScript, Node.js, Express.js, MongoDB, Jest). - We also built a live search architecture with all queries routed through a backend API for real-time, accurate results, plus history views with daily totals, per-meal grouping, and weekly summaries. Designed a 508 accessible UI with light/dark theme support using Figma.

- My team and I built a web-based contact management system using the LAMP stack (Linux, Apache, MySQL, PHP) with a remote MySQL database and JSON-based API communication.
